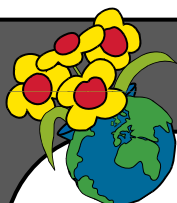

International News

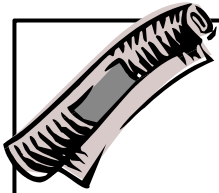
Meetings, Workshops and Recognitions
